




## GOVERNING BODY

Er. B.S. Yadav, Chairman, Governing Body, extended a warm welcome to all the members. After a brief sharing of views about the current scenario of COVID and its impact on education, Chairman requested Member Secretary to present the agenda points.

**Agenda 1: To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting held on 27/03/2021**

**Resolution:** Governing Body considered and confirmed the minutes of the previous meeting held on 27/03/2021.

**Agenda 2: Review of ongoing work regarding NBA Accreditation.**

**Resolution:** Members of the Governing Body had visited all Departments of IES College of Technology prior to the meeting, and reviewed the level of their preparedness for NBA Expert Team. During their visit, members also interacted with respective Lab Incharges, and expressed their satisfaction over the availability of Lab equipments and other infrastructure.

In the meeting, Member Secretary apprised the committee that NBA Expert Team is expected to visit in the month of October 2021, which was followed by brief presentation by HOD of the Departments applying for NBA accreditation – CSE, ME, ECE, and Electrical & Electronics Engineering. Members of Governing Body unanimously agreed that NBA accreditation is a positive step toward quality enhancement of an educational institution. They appreciated the efforts of all Department teams of IES College of Technology preparing for NBA, and wished them success in the forthcoming inspection.

**Agenda 3: Report on the increase in intake of Master of Business Administration programme by AICTE from 180 to 300 in the Academic year 2021-22, and initiation of two new programs of Marketing Management and Financial management.**

**Resolution:** Principal, IES College of Technology, and Member Secretary, Governing Body shared that in response to good admission scenario of our MBA program, it was decided to apply for the increase in intake and also start two new programs of Marketing Management and Financial Management. He further added that considering our adequate infrastructure, AICTE had granted approval for the aforementioned increase in intake of MBA and initiation of two new programs of Marketing Management and Financial management under the affiliation of Barkatullah University. The Governing Body expressed satisfaction over the news and congratulated the Principal and Management Department of IES College of Technology.

**Agenda 7: Discussion on NEP-2020 implementation as per the recent guidelines of M.P Gov.**

**Resolution:** Referring recent guidelines of M.P. Government regarding National Education Policy-2020, the Chairman of Governing Body invited all committee members for a brainstorming session on the impact of its implementation.

All members agreed that implementation of NEP-2020 would bring a significant transition in the higher education system of our country in terms of academic flexibility, credits earned by the students, and also the multiple entry-multiple exit feature of the new system. They advised the academic team of the College to successfully respond to the emerging transformation in higher education system of the country and state.

**Any other matter with the permission of Chair**

Member Secretary proposed the name of Dr. Manish Shrivastava (Professor, CSE Department) for the post of Vice Principal to strengthen the administrative decision making of IES College of Technology. Expressing satisfaction over the academic, research and administrative experience of Dr. Shrivastava, committee members unanimously approved his name for the post of Vice Principal.

It is also decided that for College to be included in 2(f) & 12(B) of the UGC Act, necessary action to be taken by the Principal.

Member Secretary further shared that two senior faculty members of College had attended “360 degree Feedback” programme organized by AICTE on September 7, 2021. Highlighting the effectiveness of 360 degree feedback system involving self assessment, he explained its significance for students, faculty and the College. Chairman reiterated to implement 360 degree feedback system with effect from 2021-22 session as per the revised Service Rule Book of IES College of Technology. Committee members considered and unanimously approved the same.
